We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father, who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, He

has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come.

May I be brought to eternal life by the blood of Jesus Christ.

(PRIEST DRINKS PRECIOUS BLOOD) (Optional: Genuflect)

THE COMMUNION

(PRIEST ADMINISTERS HOLY COMMUNION WITH BOTH BODY AND BLOOD SAYING:)

The body and blood of Christ.

(PURIFICATION OF CHALICE)

THE CONCLUDING RITE

(Prayer after Communion; see options)

Priest: "Let us pray."

Holy Father we thank you for allowing us to share in the one Bread and the one Cup of salvation (on this _____). We ask you to lead us and guide us as we follow you. All this we ask in the name of Jesus Christ Our Lord.
